We hope this letter finds everyone well. It has been almost 1 year since our March meeting discussing the possible sale of the Kings Park Psychiatric Center to the Arker Companies.

As you are aware, the Arker Companies 'only formal statement regarding their development plans can be found in their Brownsfield application. According to this application, they plan to construct 1,800 units of residential housing and ancillary uses. The units are anticipated to be a combination of age-restricted, free-market and work force units. They have placed advertisements in local papers, which have not yielded any further details.

During the past months we have continued to encourage our elected officials to protect our community and find solutions that will benefit our community s quality of life and financial well-being. This work has included several well attended Community Rallies at both the KPPC site and Senator Flangan s office. We have also gathered much information that will help in understanding the complexities of this important issue.

We invite you, along with friends and family, to attend our next meeting to discuss these important issues. Our meeting will be on January 19th at 7:15PM in the RJO Auditorium.
